* We do NOT accept cash. We take major credit cards, checks and money orders. Tuition and program fees are paid August-May. Incidentals are paid within 30 days of occurrence. No scholastic records will be released until all financial obligations have been settled. No refunds will be given for partial months used. Since the UA scholarship fully covers the tuition and program fees, the multi-child discount is not applicable. An explanation of fees can be found on the 2nd page of this document. EXPLANATION OF PROGRAM FEES*

Enrollment Fee. For the evaluations, orientation, documentation, registration, and contract preparation. \$200 for the first child and \$100 for every additional child in the same family.

Technology Fee. For the purchase, upgrade, repair and maintenance of devices and systems used in the school including Student Information System (SIS), tablets, laptops, TVs, software licenses and networking. This is an area where we intentionally invest and upgrade every year. We are able to lower the fee this year. \$150 fixed.

Book Fee. Covers the price of books charged by publishers. We do not control these prices. Students are encouraged to write constructively in their books. If a student loses or impairs a textbook or an activity book, they are required to replace it. \$600 fixed.

Printing/Testing Fee. Covers the cost of printing and testing. Our school paid 3rd party vendors \$65 and \$30 per student last year for printing and testing, respectively, to support curriculum and communication. \$100 fixed.

Activity Fee (K-5). Covers the cost of the student's Thanksgiving Family Feast meal, free family admittance to Christmas Around the World, one field trip in February or March coordinated by our office, and one on-campus Field Day in May. \$125 fixed.

Activity Fee (6-8). Covers the cost of the annual God Encounter event in October (e.g. lodging, transportation and conference fees), the student's Thanksgiving Family Feast meal, free family admittance to Christmas Around the World, and one on-campus Field Day in May. \$225 fixed.

Activity Fee (9-12). Covers the cost of the Fall Renewal event (e.g. chaperones, transportation, conference fees and t-shirt), the student's Thanksgiving Family Feast meal, free family admittance to Christmas Around the World, and one on-campus Field Day in May. \$225 fixed.

Sports Fees. Helps to cover the cost of transportation, conference fees, coaches, referees, scoring, scheduling, and uniform cleaning. \$200 first sport. \$150 each additional sport.

Additional Course Fee. Covers the additional software license associated with each course above a secondary student's normal course load. \$200 fixed.

Graduation Fee. Covers the cost of the diploma and cover, official transcripts, cap, gown and tassel, graduation ceremony, and a keepsake. Applies to 5th, 8th, and Seniors. \$200 fixed.

Early Withdrawal Fee. Covers the remaining portion of the Book Fee that is unpaid. Based on the number of remaining monthly payments. \$60-\$600.

* The total of the program fees is the same as last year: \$975 for the lower grades and \$1075 for the upper grades.

Tuition and fees are non-refundable. Program fees are not prorated if a student enrolls after the 1st quarter.

Our church and our school sponsor additional events in the Fall and Spring including Fall Field Day, Youth Nights, Love Week, and Spring Festival.
