

RECESS

We believe it is important for students to have break time during the day to decompress and release their energy. For this reason, all students have 25 minutes of recess and "brain breaks" built into their daily schedules. Everyone must adhere to the safety guidelines listed below to ensure our students' safety and well-being.

- Line leaders must stop at the entrance before entering the playground to receive instructions from the teacher or teacher assistant.
- Students are to obey the teachers and teacher assistants on recess duty.
- Students are to respect the playground equipment.
- Students are to play safely, keeping their hands and feet to themselves. Fence climbing is not permitted.
- Students should not handle or kick sticks, mulch, grass, dirt, or other objects.
- Students must obey all other school rules during recess.
- Use swings safely.
